# Hybrid Teaching - Venue 2 (Small Theatres / Seminar Room)

This teaching venue is equipped with an **EagleEye** (**Poly**) **cube camera** on the lectern. and echo-cancelling 'boundary microphone' system for the purpose of facilitating recording and/or broadcast of teaching sessions. This can be achieved using the PC built in to the lectern and some of the preinstalled university of Galway ISS supported applications, as outlined below.

# Select the correct camera, microphone and speaker equipment

Once you have logged into the application you wish to use, and before you initiate a recording or video call, please ensure that you select the correct, camera, microphone and the speaker within the application's Audio and Video settings.




- Select **Eagle Eye Cube USB** as your <u>camera</u>. You should see a picture of yourself when the above camera has been selected.
- Select "Eagle Eye Cube USB" as your microphone.
- Select Speakers / Headphones (Realtek Audio) as your <u>speaker</u>.


## Microphone for Teams/Zoom audio

Select "Microphone (EagleEye Cube USB)" for the microphone



#### Camera for Teams/Zoom video

Select "EagleEye Cube USB" as the camera




Once all your peripherals are selected you can ask your remote audience if they can see and hear you.
